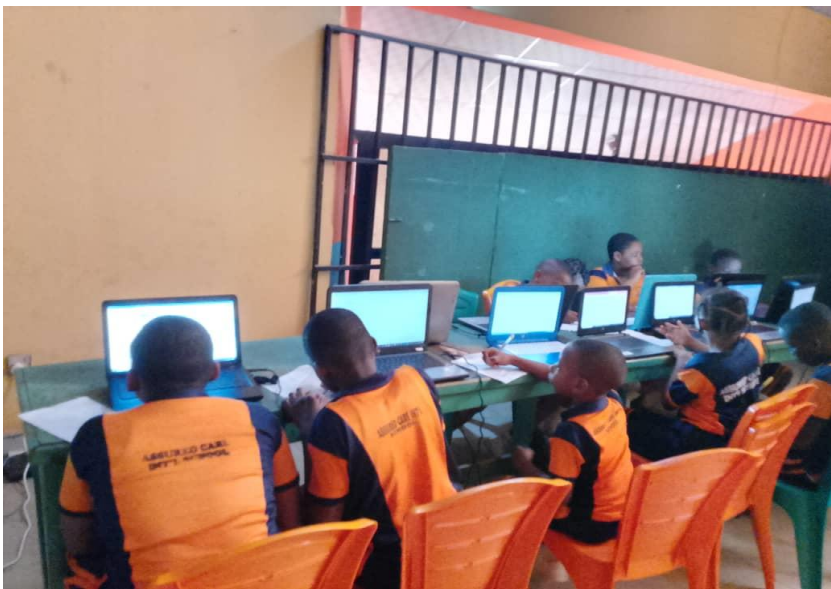
Despite our accomplishments for this year/term, we must admit that this wouldn't have been possible without your support and cooperation.
